QUESTIONS TO ASK THE DEBTOR AT SECTION 341 MEETING OF CREDITORS
BY DEBTOR'S COUNSEL
FOR CASES ASSIGNED TO TRUSTEE, DAVID WM. RUSKIN

1. State your appearance for the record.
2. Let the record reflect that I have provided the Trustee with Government issued photographic identification and proof of social security number.
3. (Verify the Chapter 13 Trustee Printout)
 - Is your name spelled correctly on the Trustee's Printout?
 - Is your address and last four digits of your Social Security number accurate on the Trustee's Printout?
4. Did you sign the petition, schedules, statements, the Plan and related documents?
5. (Show the Debtor a signed copy of the Petition and verify the signature):
 - Is this your signature on the Petition?
6. Is it a full and complete disclosure of all of your assets and everything you own?
7. Have you listed all of your liabilities and everyone you owe money to?
8. Are there any errors or omissions to bring to the Trustee's attention at this time?
9. Do you have a Domestic Support Obligation (DSO)?
 - If so, please complete the DSO form and turn in to the Trustee.
 - NOTE: The 341 cannot be concluded without completing this form.
 - NOTE: The case cannot be confirmed without proof to be provided at confirmation that this obligation is current.
10. Please proceed with any other questions relevant to the case.
