IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the Trustee is to disburse these payments, and if there are more than one of these Orders in effect and there are not sufficient funds to fully honor all payments, then and in such event, the Trustee is hereby ordered to pro-rate each disbursement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtor(s) shall maintain all policies of insurance on all property of the Debtor(s) and this estate as required by law and contract.
