

Notice Regarding Status Conferences and Contested Docket Start Times for Chapter 13 Cases Assigned to Chapter 13 Trustee, David Wm. Ruskin

April 29, 2022

Effective May 19, 2022, regarding Judge Gretchko's cases where David Ruskin is the assigned Trustee, the following process will be followed:

- **Judge Gretchko will take the bench at 10:00 a.m. to hear all contested matters.**
- **Status conferences will no longer be conducted.**
- The deadline for submission of stipulations and orders resolving or adjourning any matter will be 3:00 p.m. on the Tuesday prior to the docket date.
- Matters **not** resolved or adjourned by 3:00 p.m. on that Tuesday will be placed on the Court's contested docket.
- If a matter is resolved or an adjournment is sought after the 3:00 p.m. Tuesday deadline, **the matter will still be heard on the contested docket.** Resolutions and adjournment requests will be heard on the record.
- All contested matters will be held **in person** unless the Court excuses in person attendance. (See Judge Gretchko's Notice previously issued).
- This change in time may differ from the time on the Notice of Commencement and/or Notice of Hearing.

Effective Jun 13, 2022, regarding Judge Oxholm's dockets where David Ruskin is the assigned Trustee, the following process will be followed:

- Judge Oxholm will continue existing practice and take the bench at **1:30p.m.** to hear all contested matters.
- **Status conferences will no longer be conducted.**
- The deadline for submission of stipulations and orders resolving or adjourning any matter will be 3:00 p.m. on the Thursday prior to the docket date.
- Matters **not** resolved or adjourned by 3:00 p.m. on that Thursday will be placed on the Court's contested docket.
- If a matter is resolved or an adjournment is sought after the 3:00p.m. Thursday deadline, **the matter will still be heard on the contested docket.** Resolutions and adjournment requests will be heard on the record.
- This change in time may differ from the time on the Notice of Commencement and/or Notice of Hearing.
- **Please Note: Pursuant to Judge Oxholm's Notice previously issued, contested matters will continue to be conducted telephonically.**
