**ORDER TO PAY TAX REFUND OBLIGATIONS AFTER EXPIRATION OF PLAN
BY USING FUNDS ON HAND**

This matter came on for consideration upon a motion to dismiss for Debtor(s)' failure to remit tax refunds as required by the Chapter 13 Plan, filed by the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee in accordance with LBR 9014-1 (EDM) and the parties having agreed to the withdrawal of the Trustee's motion to dismiss conditioned on the terms herein, and based on the records of the Court and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised in the premises;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, notwithstanding the expiration of the Chapter 13 Plan by its terms, the Debtor(s) remain(s) obligated to remit certain tax refunds received during the pendency of this case, pursuant to the Order Confirming Plan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Trustee shall be and is authorized to use the funds currently on hand toward satisfaction of the Debtor(s)' tax refund obligations under the Plan to the extent available.
